

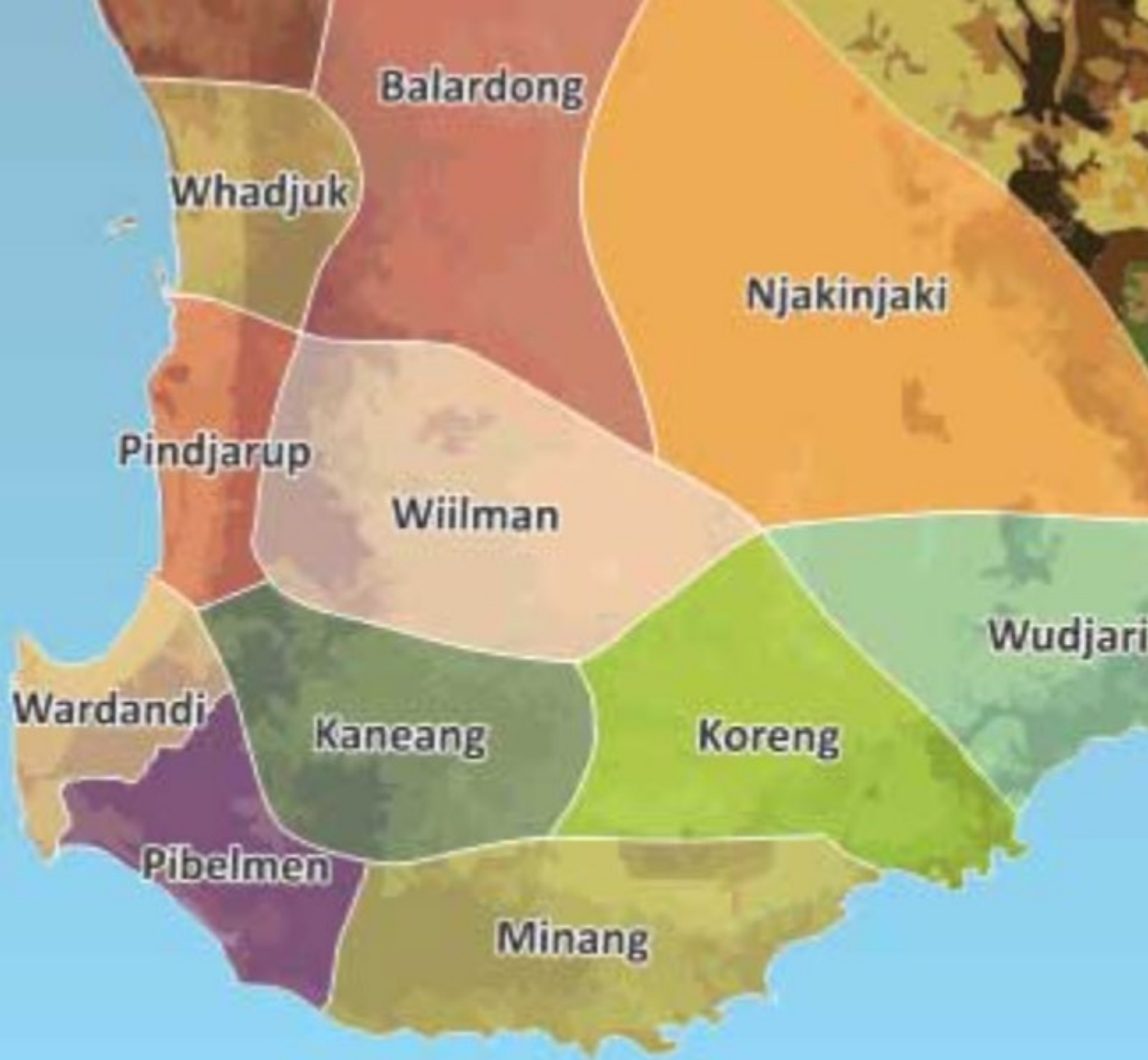

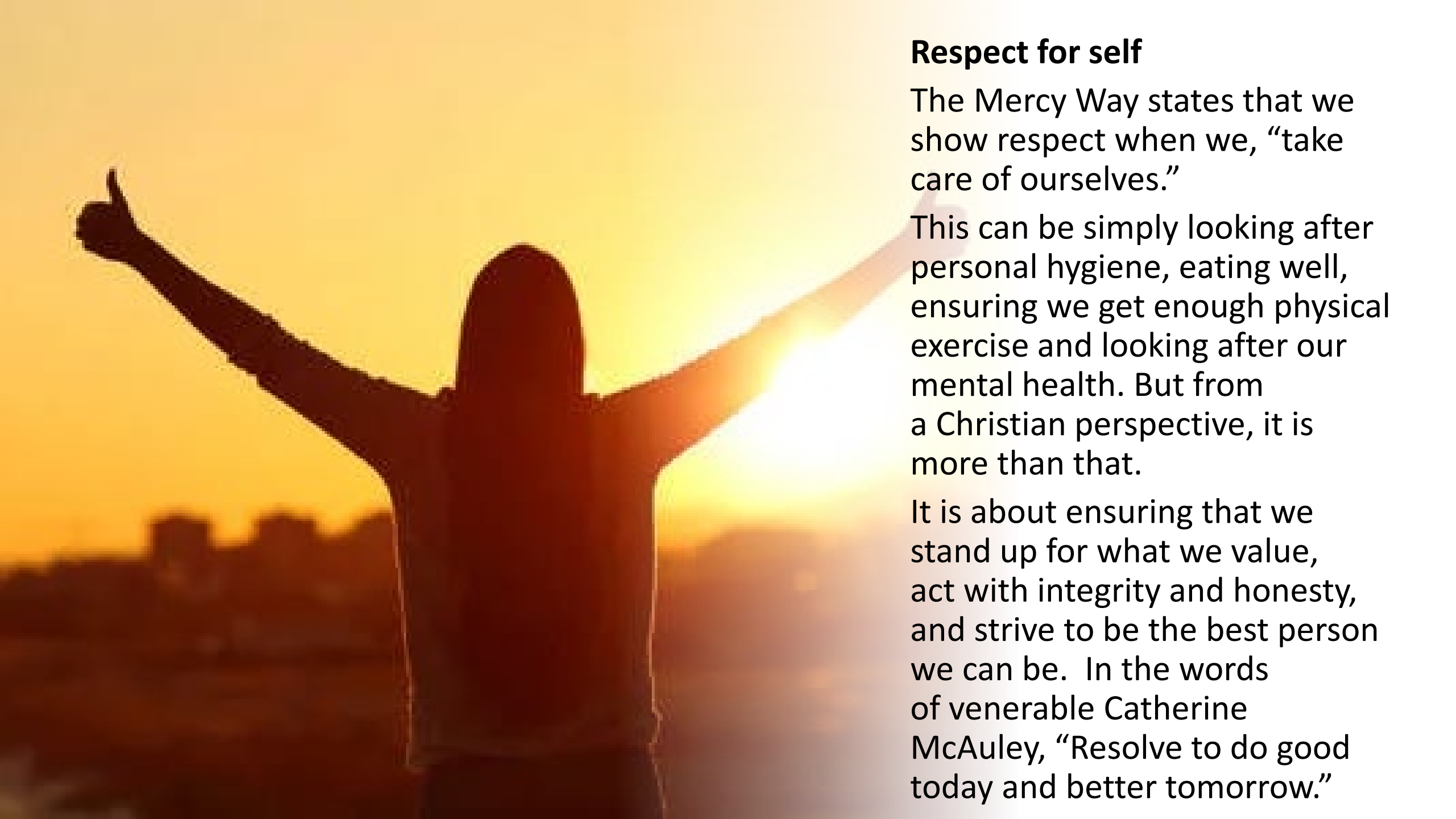
## **Respect for Others**

St Paul, in a letter to the people of Phillipi, encouraged them to,

*“Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility, value others above yourselves.”*

This is at the heart of respect for others, recognising the inherent dignity and worth of everybody and placing their interests above our own, taking care that our words and actions do no harm, and not judging others because of their differences.
